



£100,000 CHALLENGE FUND CRITERIA

To celebrate the fifteenth anniversary of the Landfill Communities Fund, Yorventure is launching a Challenge Fund of £100,000

Applications are invited for Public Amenity or Environmental conservation projects complying with Objects DA or D of the Landfill Communities Fund. The successful Project, chosen by Yorventure's Funding Panel, will receive a grant of £100,000.

Eligible Organisations

- Community Groups
- Charitable Organisations
- Trusts
- Local Authorities/Parish Councils

Project Location

- The project must be within 10 miles of a Yorwaste landfill site but projects within closer proximity will be favoured.

Project Types

- Environmental improvements or conservation work complying with Entrust Category DA criteria.
- Public Amenities eg village halls, play areas, community woodlands complying with Entrust Category D criteria.

Funding Available

- £100,000 for a single project

Match Funding

- Applicants must be able to demonstrate that local fundraising has been carried out and that other organisations have been formally applied to for funding.
- Yorventure must be the largest contributor.

Community Support

- Priority will be given to projects which demonstrate wide community support for their project, through public consultation exercises and support letters.

Timescales

- Applications must be received by 30 September 2011
- The Funding Panel expects to announce the winning application during November.
- The project must be able to spend the grant within fifteen months of the award.

PR and Communication

The project must have a suitable communication plan which will publicise the Landfill Communities Fund, and Yorventure's affiliation with the project.
